relating to a woman who has or is having a baby



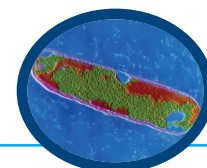
ne-o-na-tal [nee-oh-neyt-l] adjective

a disease caused by bacteria that usually enter the body through a cut or wound

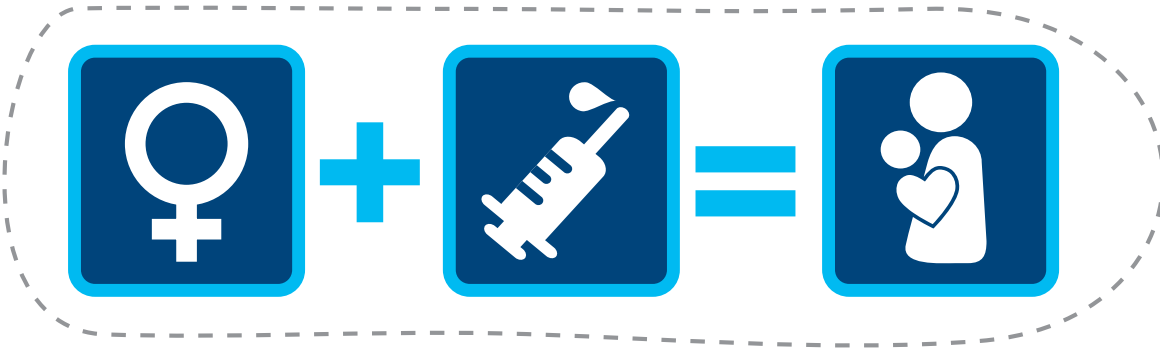
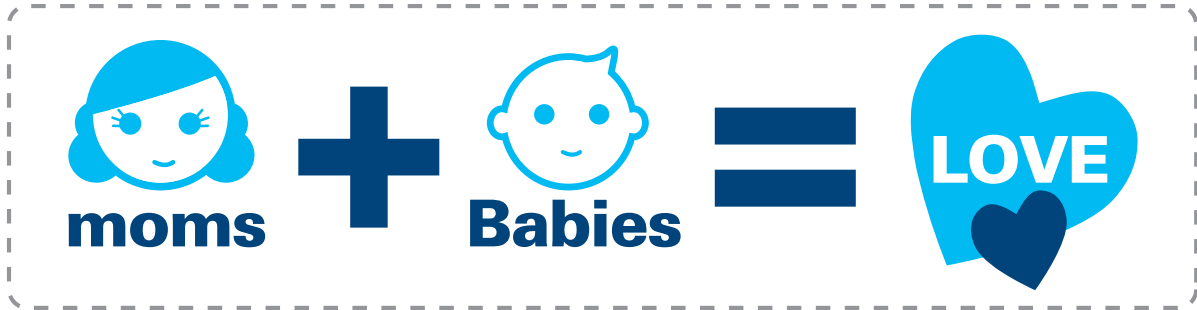


The bacteria: Clostridium tetani
